星期三(7/13)即聽說有颱風生成,將在17~18日影響台灣,盤算著畢祿、羊頭之行是否會受影響,星期五接到通知;出發時間不變,但有兩個備用方案。

颱風前的天空總是特別晴朗,星期六(7/16)07:45來到中山足球場,車上早已坐上好些兔友,07:50全員到齊,往埔里出發。此時依舊晴空萬里,領隊Wino(曹俊彥)向兔友簡報行程,預計下午兩點到達合歡山區,將先行攀登合歡主峰、東峰及石門山三座百岳,再視天候狀況決定是否進行畢祿、羊頭縱走;11:50到達埔里用餐,12:20出發往合歡山。

霧社過後經過清靜農場,此地人山人海,雖然風景優美,但處處可見人為不當開發,櫻峰至昆陽路段,右側雲霧中隱約可見卡賀爾山、奇萊南峰、卡羅樓山及奇萊主山;昆陽過後公路左側為高山草原,遠方可見台灣公路最高點武嶺,此時方才籠罩奇萊山區的雲霧也已散去;14:30抵達合歡山登山口,換裝14:40出發15:10登頂合歡主峰標高3416m, Rolling Stone(張仁全)說的好,山要遠觀才美,登山是為了看遠山;此時萬里無雲整個奇萊山區就在眼前,山容峻峭聳拔,台灣「高山十峻」之一的奇萊北峰看的更加清晰。

下山到武嶺停車場稍事休息後15:40由合歡山莊前的東峰登山口攀登東峰,16:40登頂合歡東峰,標高3416m,領隊Wino(曹俊彥)說,攀登合歡東峰10餘次從沒見到這麼好的天氣,天空依舊晴朗,北望南湖大山、中央尖、合歡北峰、西峰,東方的屏風山,東南方的奇萊主山北峰,南方的奇萊主山、卡羅樓山、奇萊裏山...全都歷歷在目,拍完登頂照開始下山17:10回到登山口,部分兔友繼續攀登合歡尖山,我則在此休息,此時山上氣溫只有10.3℃,17:35兔友攀登合歡尖山歸來,出發前往石門山登山口。

17:40石門山登山口(離公路最近的百岳來回只需20min),遠方有些雲霧,等到登頂石門山時,山頂已被雲霧籠罩;海棠颱風來襲,早上先是會長轉達國家公園的關心,提醒我們注意氣象報告,下午又陸續接到電話要我們不要上山(此時早就在山上了),最後Hobo(曹博彥)還是接到警政署的電話要求我們下山,大夥就在石門山頂開會,三座百岳輕鬆入袋,又見到如此壯麗的高山美景,畢祿、羊頭縱走就留待下回了,決定下山到埔里Bash夜宿埔里;Whore House(李盛填)緊急聯絡兔友Shit Mountain(徐德山),幫忙找到舒適又高級的住宿地點;Bash就在飯店附近的夜市,席開兩桌共飲啤酒3箱、清酒4瓶,深夜12點才依依不捨的回住處。

17日早上埔里無風無雨,絲毫不見颱風的跡象,市區觀光後回台北,車經苗栗天空烏雲密布,不時刮著陣風下著陣雨,在苗栗用餐後直奔中山足球場,14:20回到台北,結束這愉快的不見畢祿、羊頭的畢祿、羊頭行。

“July has come in on golden wings, and the weather was kind of weather to make a poet sing, a lover love” , so wrote P.G. Wodehouse in his novel ‘Money for Nothing’ published in 1928!

He also writes:

“An American statistician has estimated that, omitting substitutes like “all Right” , “You bet” , ‘OK’ , and nasal expressions like “Uh-Huh” , the English language provides nearly fifty different methods of replying in the affirmative, including Yeah, Yeth, Yum, Yo, Yaw, Chess, Chas, Chuss, Yip, Yep, Yop, Yup, Yurp...”

We, East Indians, over 5000 years, have used a simple method which none can beat: Shake one’s head ‘up and down’ (twice for emphasis) for a ‘yes’ ; shake ‘left to right (also twice for emphasis) for a ‘no’ !!!!! ON! ON!

It was such a lovely day last Saturday when we assembled at a farm house, somewhere in a remote, beautiful valley in Quan Si., for our Hash run. It took more than one hour by car to get there. We parked our cars just around a bridge, close to the animal farm, a few hundred meters from a main road. The cows were mooing from their sheds, and the stink of cow-dung was prevalent, that I had to hold my kerchief to my nose.

Anyway, the valley from where the run was set was really beautiful. It was surrounded on all sides by hills, all green with thickly crowded tall pine trees, bamboos, and all sorts of cultivation. Beyond, the mountains in the background had different shades of blue and the horizon was painted in multicolor.

At least a dozen of our hashers, unfortunately that includes me sometimes, take off on the run even before the hares have left, hoping to get to the pre-marked trail without hurrying (usually the beginning and the end of the run would not have been marked before the hares officially leave). This time, the culprits had no clue in which direction to go and had to follow the hares soon after they left.

After a short run up the main road, we turned right to a narrow trail, going up-hill, for a short while when we came to a check. It was an easy check, and we scrambled through bushes amidst bamboo and banana on the sides, and soon got to some nice tracks where we could run along for a while without ado. After a short run along a black top road, we turned to the hills. The pack dragged along through lacings of branches and bushes, sometimes getting stuck, having to cross gutters, crevices, dry streams etc. We then got to an intersection, where the long and short runs were clearly marked. Most of us took the long run.

I took the long run. After running along a dirt road for a while, we slowly turned up hill to a mountain for a long while. We passed along some hummocks to get to the top of the mountains. We ran along the ridges for a while, on the crescent, hammered on all sides by bushes of thorn, raggedy clumps of trees, fallen tree trunks and rocky slopes that made going slow and difficult.

The sun was at its zenith, at least so it seemed. It was very hot when we ran through a tea plantation for a while, on open ground, with no shade. But it was a real sight to watch Hashers moving on a green

carpet, far and wide. From the plantation, we ran down hill, and then along a very narrow trail on a slope, going down hill. Somewhere along there, wasps attacked. I was stung behind my neck, and in shock I removed my cap and swung at it, and in the process slipped and almost fell on my knees into a ditch below and got cramps on my right leg at the same time. I managed to get up with minor bruises, and then bolted in panic. Few others also got stung. Even after four days, the swelling is still there on my neck, though, thank God, the pain was minimal compared to the itching.

Then, after a short run, we got to a black top road, ran a short distance before we turned to another hill and slowly climbed up to the top, along a long winding trail. Once on the ridge, we continued through thick brush, up and down, where crickets and beetles kept singing 'On! On! .

Before we ran in to the finish, we had a long run along a nice path, with lacings of brushes and grass. All in all a very good run indeed.

Hare 'Sesame' , who is an experienced hasher, always have set very good runs, unlike the fast running gay couple, who wants to monopolize haring our hash runs. Congratulations to Sesame and his co-hare 'Golden Boy' ?
